Mr. LeBlanc is the Counterintelligence & Insider Threat Program Manager / Senior Official (ITPSO) for SAIC. He is responsible for planning and executing all aspects of the CI and Insider Threat programs to include identification, collection, analysis, investigation, reporting and mitigation of identified concerns. Additionally, he serves as the Chair of the Insider Threat Working Group (ITWG) where he gathers recommendations from the other assigned ITWG stakeholders pertaining to inquiries and investigations, and risk mitigation as well as outreach to external partner CI representatives.

Mr. LeBlanc previously served as the Counterintelligence Manager and Program Security Officer for Scitor Corporation where he supported multiple Intelligence Community and Department of Defense customers. In this role he was responsible for maintaining all aspects of the Scitor Security program to include, counterintelligence, personnel security, physical security, training and awareness, and support for customer meetings and assessments.

Prior to joining Scitor, Mr. LeBlanc was the Chief, Customer Relations Branch at the National Reconnaissance Office as an active duty Air Force Senior Non-Commissioned Officer. He directed the personnel security management of over 80,000 cleared personnel, including project management, process improvement, and policy compliance. Mr. LeBlanc also developed a centralized annual access verification to identify cleared personnel who no longer had a strict need-to-know resulting in the debriefing of hundreds of personnel annually who no longer had the need to be cleared.

Mr. LeBlanc also served as Senior Program Security Officer, within the Imagery Intelligence (IMINT) Directorate. In this role, he provided support to the Research & Technology Branch. Among his accomplishments he provided cradle to grave security support to cutting edge technology programs, many of which have been deployed operationally. Mr. LeBlanc also served as an Adjudicator, within the Office of Security for the National Reconnaissance Office. He led the branch's Monitoring Program which was tasked with providing continuous monitoring and communications with individuals with higher risk.

Prior to being assigned to the National Reconnaissance Office, LeBlanc served on Air Force active duty in various roles and locations around the globe to include, Military Working Dog Kennelmaster, Trainer and Handler. He also was a Flight Shift Supervisor, Dispatcher, Senior Patrolman, Missile Operations Support member and Emergency Services Team member.

LeBlanc started his career in the U.S. Air Force in 1991 and retired from active duty in 2011 at which time he joined Scitor.

LeBlanc is a certified Insider Threat Program Manager through Carnegie Mellon University's, Systems Engineering Institute. He is a certified investigator through the John E. Reid and Associates Institute. He is a member of INSA, InfraGard, DCSA CI Partnership with Cleared Industry (CIPCI), the Open Source Insider Threat Working Group (OSIT), and Domestic Security Alliance Council (DSAC).
